## Offering Help

## การเสนอความช่วยเหลือ

- 1. Can I help you?
- 2. Would you like me to help?
- 3. Let me help you.
- 4. Can I give you a hand? (give a hand = help)
- 5. May I assist you? (assist=help)



## **Accepting Help**

### การตอบรับความช่วยเหลือ

- 1. Thank you very much. You're so kind.
- 2. Thanks. It's very kind/nice of you.
- 3. Please, thank you.
- 4. That would be great, thank you.



## **Refusing Help**

## การปฏิเสธความช่วยเหลือ

- 1. Thanks a lot, but I think I should do it myself.
- 2. Thank you very much, but I should be responsible for that.
- 3. It's alright, I can deal with it. But, thank you anyway.
- 4. It's fine, I can do it myself.



## **Requesting Help**

## การขอความช่วยเหลือ

- 1. Can/Could you...(verb)... please?
- 2. Can you help me?
- 3. Would you mind...(verb+ing)...?
- 4. Do you mind...(verb+ing)...?
- 5. I wonder if you can help me?



## Accepting Request for Help

การตอบรับการขอความช่วยเหลือ

- 1. Yes./Yes, of course.
- 2. Sure!
- 3. No problem!
- 4. Yes, sure!



## Refusing Request for Help

การปฏิเสธการขอความช่วยเหลือ

- 1. Sorry./I'm sorry
- 2. I'm sorry. I need it myself.
- 3. I'm afraid I can't



## **Expressing an opinion**

## การเห็นด้วย (agreeing) ทางการ

- 1. I agree (with you).
- 2. So do I.
- 3. That's a good/great idea.
- 4. You're right.

### การเห็นด้วย (agreeing) ไม่เป็นทางการ

- 1. Good idea!
- 2. That sounds great!
- 3. Wonderful!
- 4. That's what I think!
- 5. That's great!
- 6. Awesome!



## **Expressing an Opinion**

## การไม่เห็นด้วย (disagreeing)

- 1. I don't agree (with you).
- 2. I think you're wrong.
- 3. I don't think so.
- 4. I'm not sure.
- 5. I don't think it works.
- 6. I wouldn't do that.
- 7. I don't think it's a good idea.

## การถามความคิดเห็นเพิ่มเติม

- 1. Do you have any (good) ideas?
- 2. Do you have anything else?
- 3. Any more ideas you'd like to share?

## **Conversation**
